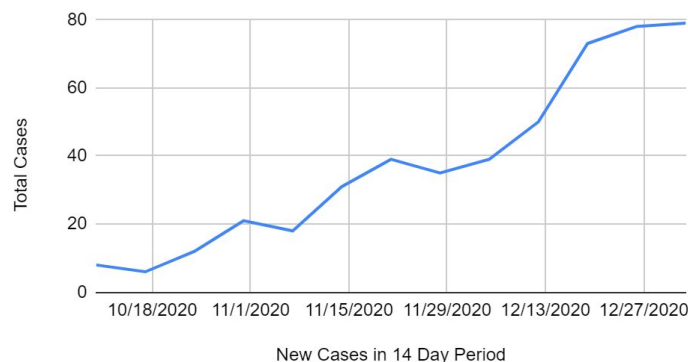

Dear Staff and Parents,

This is another update on positive COVID-19 cases and contacts. We have two new positive cases and multiple contacts. We continue to follow all of the mitigation strategies in school. Please remember that if your child is ill, please do not send them to school. Any symptoms must be taken seriously to avoid the spread of this highly contagious virus.

Today we had an additional two positive cases and 10 contacts. I have been communicating with each homeroom class if your child is required to quarantine due to exposure to a positive case. I would like to acknowledge the many people who are working hard to communicate, contact trace and do everything possible to keep students safe and give them an opportunity to be in school in person. This includes parents, bus drivers, teachers, paraprofessionals, support staff, office staff, nurses and administrators. We need to continue to do everything possible to flatten the curve. We have not flattened the curve yet, but together we can do our best and as we begin to be vaccinated, this will help. During the last 14 days, ending on 1/2/21, Brooklyn has had 89 new positive cases.
